As we reach the Easter break I write to thank you for your support in ensuring that your child is wearing appropriate uniform. As parents and carers it is vital you play a key role in assisting us to ensure that high standards of uniform are met by all our students. To enable you to perform this role we would just like to remind you of a number of our uniform expectations:

- Skirts must be plain, dark grey or black and must be of a standard length.
- Trousers must be plain, dark grey or black and must be worn at the waist.
- The school jumper/sweatshirt bears the school logo. Non school jumpers, cardigans or denim are not permitted.
- Shoes must be low-heeled and black. No trainers, mules, sandals or stilettos.
- No jewellery, other than sleeper or stud earrings to be worn in the ear lobe.
- Hairstyles must be an appropriate style and colour.

Any student contravening the uniform rules will be isolated from mainstream education until the issue is remedied.
